

Election of the President 2017-2020

Electronic ballots received

A total of 201 electronic ballots were received as follows:

- 189 fully completed
- 12 partially completed therefore 'spoilt'
- Of the 189 fully completed responses 83% chose to respond in English with 98% of those (151 Fellows) voting YES and 2% (3 Fellows) voting NO
- Of the 189 fully completed responses 18% chose to respond in Welsh with 97% of those (32 Fellows) voting YES and 3% (1 Fellow) voting NO

Paper ballots received

A total of 6 paper ballots were received as follows:

- Of the 6 completed responses, 4 chose to respond in English
- Of the 6 completed responses, 2 chose to respond in Welsh
- All 6 of those Fellows who returned the ballot paper voted YES

Of the 426 current Fellows 195 responses were received for the Presidential Ballot with 191 responses marked with a YES vote and 4 responses marked with a NO vote.
